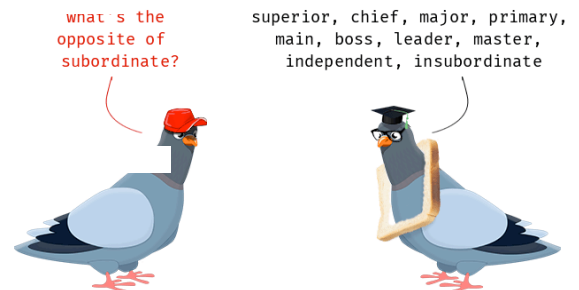


Words for Recognition:
