Example you / be

Q: Have you (ever) been to a basketball game?

A: Yes, I have. I have been to a basketball game.



1. Tina / be to the US / never

Q: Has Tina (ever) been to the US?

A: No, she hasn't. She has never been there.



2. you / swim in the ocean / three times

Q: Have you (ever) swum in the ocean?

A: Yes, I have. I have swum in the ocean (three times).



3. Tina / give the cat a bath / twice

Q: Has Tina (ever) given the cat a bath?

A: Yes, she has. She has given the cat a bath (twice).

2. they / leave Taiwan

Q: Have they left Taiwan (yet)?

A: No, they haven't. They haven't left Taiwan (yet).



3. Joe / send Cindy a card

Q: Has Joe sent Cindy a card (yet)?

A: No, he hasn't. He hasn't sent Cindy a card (yet).
