
## Part A Write down the history of the food.

The French gave the world the first **hairdryer**, **paper** machine, hot air balloon, and bikini. They even gave the USA the Statue of Liberty. However, French fries have a different history.

The earliest French fries were from Belgium along the Meuse River in the late 17th century. It was common for people in the area to catch and fry fish, but that was difficult when the river froze in the winter. When they could not catch fish for food, they would cut potatoes into long thin sticks and fry them.

During World War I, American soldiers in Belgium tasted this
delicious food for the first time. They called these fried potatoes
"French fries" because French was the main language there.
They also took the food back to the USA. Since then, French fries have become popular all over the world.
