(5) Lots of parents like to share things about their children. With different social media, parents now tell funny stories about their children and put pictures of them on the Internet. Over 90% of parents have the experience of uploading their children's pictures or videos online. To talk about this phenomenon, people even made the word "sharenting" by putting "share" and "parenting" together.

Sharenting is highly controversial. Some people think there's nothing wrong with it, but some people think it might hurt children in many ways. When parents put those pictures online, they are sharing them with the world because nothing on the Internet is fully private. Second, those pictures belong to (屬於) the children, not their parents. However, parents should think twice before they do it and care more about their children's feelings when they are putting any pictures online.
