7 Minutes	Play game Dobble:	board	
	• Sit in groups of 4 to 5 students.	game	
	• On each card, there are 4 pictures, some are big, and		
	some are small		
	• On any two cards, there's only one picture that is		
	the same.		

	Shuffle the cards.		
	 Put one card face down in front of each person. 		
	Make a draw pile.		
	 Put the card face up on top of the draw pile. 		
	 Each person flips his/her card face up. 		
	• Find the same picture between his/her card and the		
	card on the top of the draw pile.		
	 Say the matching pictures' word out loud. 		
	 Count the cards to decide the winner.

	• Students practice the sentence patterns again.	set.
