TikTok-Induced Tourette Syndrome

Tourette Syndrome (TS) is a **disorder** that causes young children around the ages of five to ten to start acting in strange ways. They may start making some sudden movements or repeating the same sounds over and over again. These sudden movements are call "tics," and someone with TS cannot control them. TS is more common in boys than girls and has no **cure**. Usually, TS goes away once the child becomes an **adult**, but it sometimes becomes worse as they get older.

TS became very popular on the social media app TikTok. Some people with TS uploaded videos showing what their life with TS was like. In 2020, these videos ended up setting off a surprising **phenomenon** as a result. David Martino, a TS doctor in Alberta, Canada, noticed that he was getting many more new TS **patients**, **especially** girls. These girls often showed the same kinds of tics that someone with TS had a video about on TikTok. The doctor believes that these new patients could either try to look cool by copying something popular from social media or have a real other disorder going on that decided to show itself in this way.

Because of this, scientists have called this "functional tic-like behaviors." In any case, they warn that this does not make the disorder less real or serious.
