Jamie: Er, look. You did. You were in the kitchen at 2 a.m.

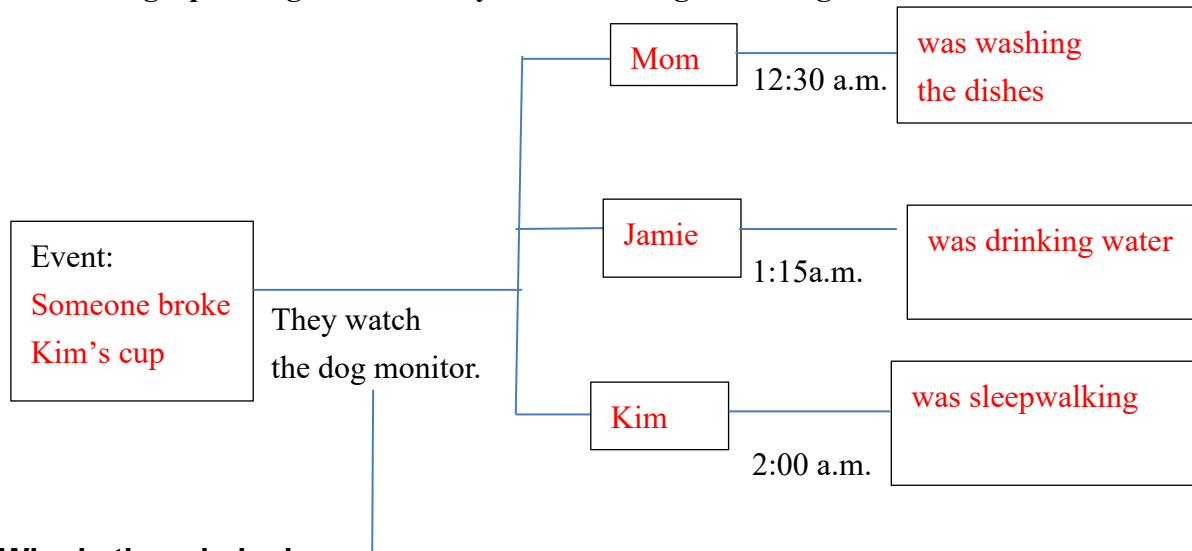
Kim: I was in the kitchen? I don't remember that at all.

Someone Was in My Room

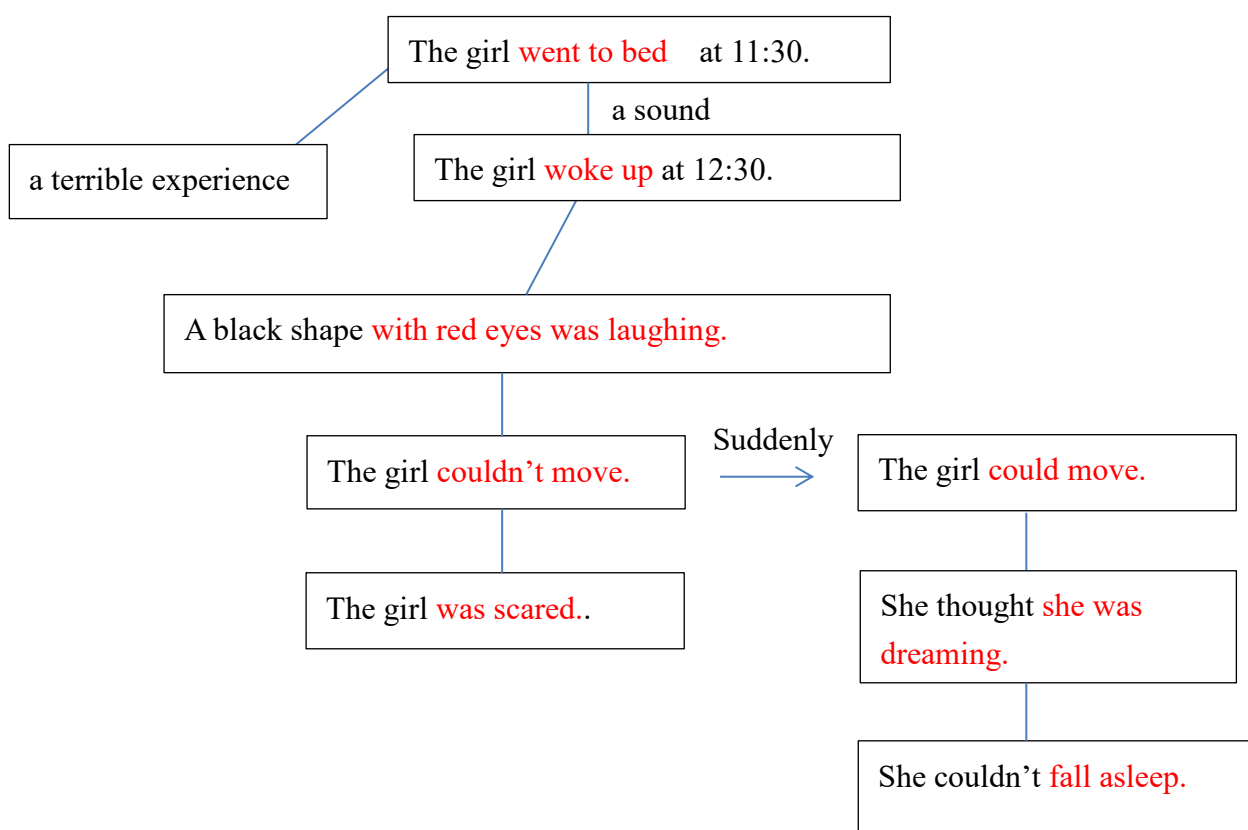
I had a terrible experience last night. I went to bed at half past eleven, but a sound woke me up an hour later. Someone was in my room.
