6. What would you do if you were the waiter?

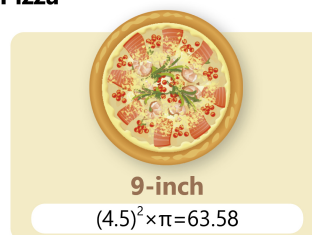
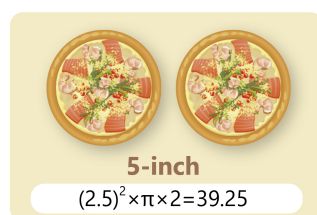
