


Picture that you're shopping. You go into a store with no clerks or **shopkeepers**. Right away, your **cellphone** shows you where to find the things on your shopping list. You **collect** everything, and you leave the store. When you're **outside**, your phone tells you if the money has been paid from your online **wallet** successfully. Very convenient, isn't it? Well, thanks to IoT, there are stores just like this now.

IoT stands for Internet of things. The idea is to make things "smart" by connecting them to the Internet and having them share information with each other. For example, when you get home and are opening the door with your key, your phone will tell your house that you're back. So, even before you hit the **couch**, the **lamps** are already on and the TV is set to your favorite **program**. IoT makes our lives easier.

More and more companies are now designing IoT products. Soon, these **modern** products will be everywhere, and we won't even know they are there. No one can know for sure how IoT will shape our lives. We will have to **cross that bridge when we come to it**.






