<b>Time</b>	40 mins	<b>Classes</b>	One class
<b>Materials</b>	Picture book "Maisy's Chinese New Year", online video, spring couplet		
<b>Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● to understand the Chinese New Year culture</li> <li>● to say years of animal's name</li> <li>● to develop reading skills</li> </ul>		
<b>Teaching procedures</b>			
<p><b>Before reading : 10 mins</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Have the students look at the illustration first and ask what they think the story might be?</li> <li>• Ask "What do you see on the book cover?" and "What happened in the picture?" have students practice saying Chinese New Year.</li> <li>• Ask them what do you do during Chinese New Year?</li> </ul> <p><b>While reading : 20 mins</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using flashcards to show them the key words before reading.</li> <li>• Have students read the story.</li> <li>• Have one of the students read aloud, and the rest of the class follows.</li> <li>• Explain the words they don't understand.</li> </ul> <p><b>After reading : 10 mins</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check students' comprehension, and ask them what red things they can find in the book.</li> <li>• Review the names and order of the animals and ask them what animal you are.</li> <li>• Have students draw a Chinese dragon spring couplet and wish them good luck.</li> </ul>
