3	How many questions did the students ask? What are they?	They asked John four questions. (1) How did you become a firefighter? (2) What do you usually do at work? (3) Can you tell us about an exciting or dangerous experience? (4) Why are there so many fires?
4	What do firefighters usually do at work?	They put out fires, save people and teach people about fire safety rules.

	Questions	Sample Answers		
1	What does Tina mean when she says "That's a lot"?	The workload is heavy. They have many things to do.		
2	How does Jack feel when he says "You are like a superhero"? Why does he say this?	The experience John shares with the class is hard for Jack to imagine. It is like a scene from a superhero movie, not real life. (答案僅供參考)		
3	Why do you think John is speaking about his job to the class?	I think that the teacher or the school invited him to the class to describe his work as a firefighter, so the students can learn about different jobs. (答案僅供參考)		
4	John Lee said "After passing the exam, I had to take several more training classes." What do you think the training classes are about?	The training classes might be about building up body strength, putting out fires quickly, saving people from fires, or jumping out of the windows in a tall building. (答案僅供參考)		
5	Why does the teacher say, "His job means a lot to us, doesn't it" at the end?	The job is difficult and has a high risk of injury and even death, but firefighters are brave because they save people and make the world a better place. (依學生程度 調整中英比例,若學生遇到高層次提問而無法以英文回答,可以中文表達。)
