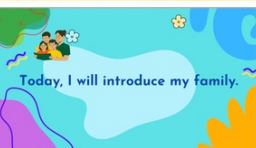

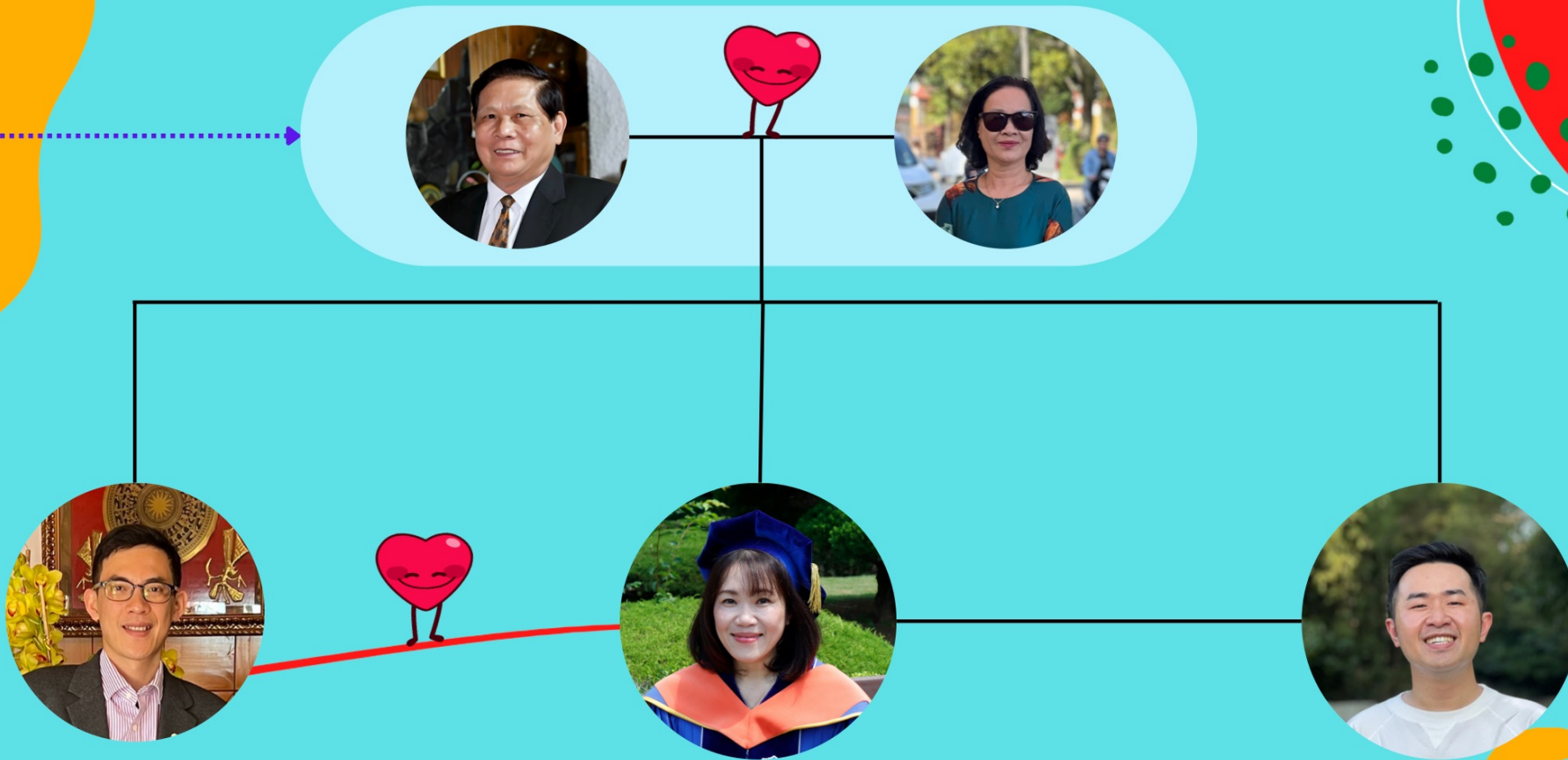


In my family, I have **one sister**.
