Topic : Celebrating International Women's Day

Grade Level: Junior High School (Grade 8)

• Objective:

Students will understand the significance of International Women's Day. Students will practice reading, listening, and speaking skills in English.

• Materials Needed:

Projector and screen

PPT on the screen about influential women

Blackboard and chalk

Computers/tablets for research (optional)

- Procedure:
- I. Introduction (10 minutes):
- Begin by discussing the concept of International Women's Day (IWD). Ask students what they know about it and why it's celebrated.
- 2. Show a short video clip (2-3 minutes) about the history and purpose of IWD.
- 3. Discuss the significance of celebrating women's achievements and promoting gender equality globally.
- II. Reading Comprehension (15 minutes):
- 1. Distribute reading passages or articles about notable women from different cultures and fields (e.g., Malala Yousafzai, Marie Curie, Frida Kahlo).
- 2. Have students read individually or in pairs.
- 3. Ask comprehension questions to check understanding and facilitate a brief discussion about the challenges these women faced and their contributions.
- III. DIY time: Thank-You Cards (15 minutes) with foreigh teacher-Elizabelth
- 1. Make thank-you cards for the women that are important to you.
- 2. Share and read your cards with the class
- IV. Wrap Up (5 minutes)
- 1. Quick review about global Women's Day.
- 2. Ask Studetns to take cards home and send them to the women that are important to you .
- 3. Take pictures with the ones that are important and post them on Padlet.
