Taiwan again shows itself to be a welcoming country.

Over the last few years in Taiwan, you have probably noticed more restaurants saying that they're Muslim-friendly. At popular tourist destinations like TAIPEI 101, you might have seen signs pointing to Mecca, Islam's most important city. There are also more and more public restrooms claiming they're suitable for Muslims. So why is Taiwan suddenly so focused on Islam?

To answer that question, it's important to first note that Taiwan's population includes around fifty to sixty thousand Muslims who were born in the country. When you include visiting students and foreign workers, the number of Muslims living here totals more than three hundred thousand. In addition, the number of tourists visiting Taiwan from Muslim countries is always increasing.

Secondly, it's worth keeping in mind that this growing number is a good thing. Having more tourists is obviously good because it helps businesses make more money. Having more Muslims making this country their home is also great, as the beauty of their culture can add something new to life here.

Finally, the changes being made to make Taiwan more friendly to Muslims have been quite easy to do. Probably the only difficult thing has been making sure that Muslim-friendly restaurants follow Islam's halal food preparation rules. These rules govern the way that animals are killed, and the way that all food is stored and prepared. Although most Taiwanese people don't need to eat halal food, almost everyone would be happy to have it.

Making Taiwan a Muslim-friendly country has been quite simple, and it helps us all in lots of different ways. The most important thing is that as the Taiwanese take pride in being friendly and welcoming to different people, helping Muslims live or vacation here more comfortably should leave us all feeling happy.
