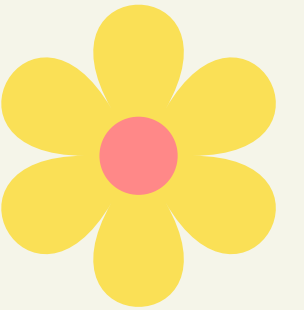

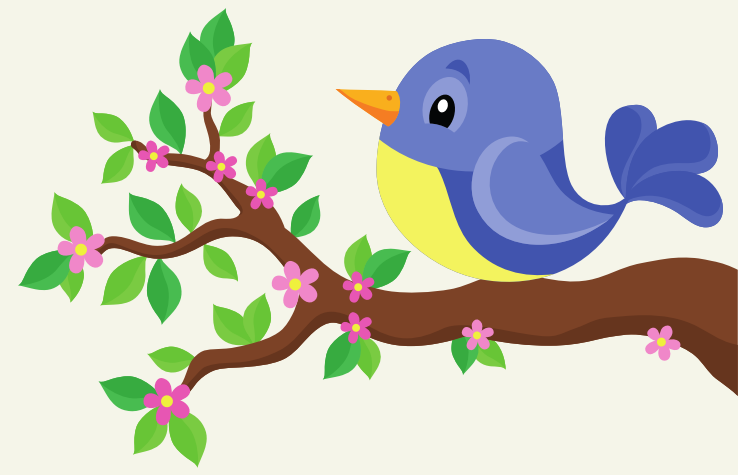

and murmuring streams are softly caressed by the breezes.

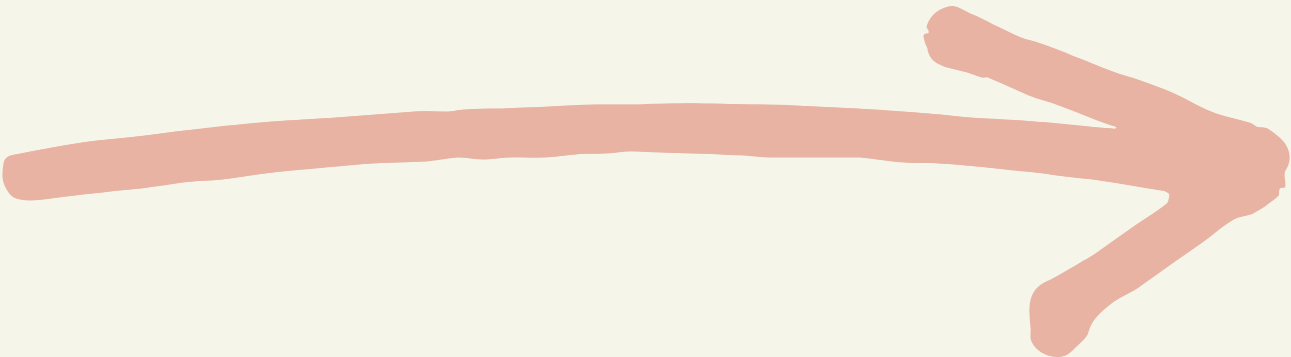
Thunderstorms, those heralds of Spring, roar,

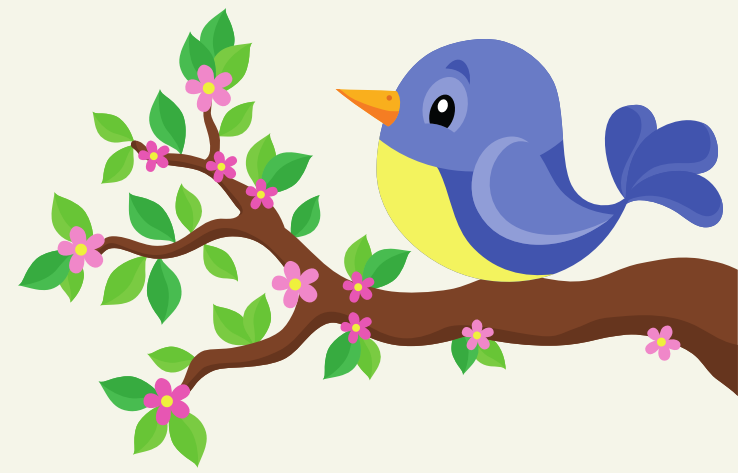

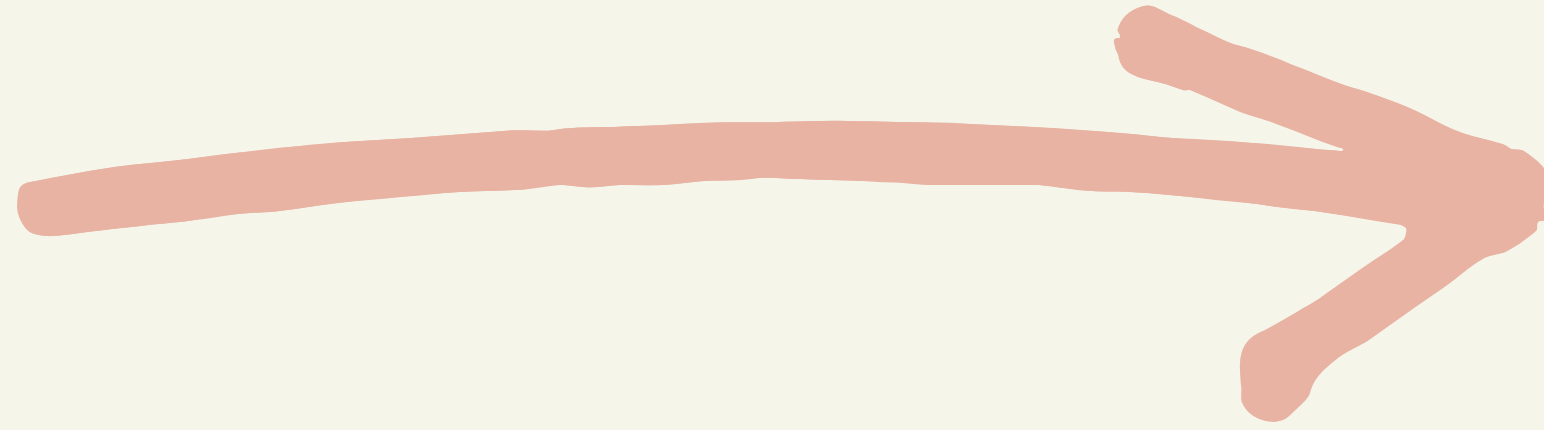
## Allegro
