Follow-Up Questions:

Follow-Up Questions:

- (1) How did you develop this talent or skill? Did someone teach you, or are you self-taught?
- (2) How often do you practice or use this talent/skill?
- (3) Have you ever performed or showcased your talent/skill in public? How did it go?

5. What places in your town or city do you like to visit, and what do you do there?

Follow-Up Questions:

- (1) What makes this place special or interesting to you?
- (2) Who do you usually go with when you visit this place?
- (3) Are there any local foods or treats you enjoy when you visit this place?

6. If you could travel anywhere in the world, where would you go and why?

Follow-Up Questions:

- (1) What specific landmarks or attractions would you like to see there?
- (2) Have you traveled to any interesting places before? What was your favorite trip?
- (3) What do you think would be the biggest challenge or most exciting part of visiting this destination?

7. What are some popular trends or fashions among teenagers in your country right now?

Follow-Up Questions:

- (1) Do you follow any of these trends or have a favorite fashion style?

(2) How do you keep up with the latest trends? (e.g., social media, friends, magazines)

(3) Are there any trends you don't like or find strange?

8. How do you stay in touch with your friends, and what do you like to do together?

Follow-Up Questions:

(1) Do you prefer chatting online, talking on the phone, or meeting in person?

(2) What's the most fun or memorable thing you've done with your friends recently?

(3) Do you have any traditions or special activities you always do with your friends?

9. What kind of movies or TV shows do you like to watch?

Follow-Up Questions:

(1) Who are your favorite actors or actresses?

(2) Do you watch movies or TV shows in English, and do you find it helps with your language learning?

(3) Have you ever been to a movie theater recently? What did you watch, and did you enjoy it?

10. What's your impression on Indonesia?

Follow-Up Questions:
