(1) Strengths : <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The teacher started the class with a greeting and the lesson objectives.- The teacher used both English and Chinese as the mediums of instruction. When she said something in English, she made sure to translate it into Chinese for better understanding.- She used interactive tools for her lesson.- She started her lesson with the question, "Have you ever say sorry to others in the past week" which I think is very good since the students had the opportunity to think. She also gave options to choose from so they wouldn't be afraid to answer.- The teacher also provided encouraging words to help students feel comfortable answering in both English and Chinese.- The teacher reviewed their previous lesson and integrated it with the current lesson.- The teacher used an interactive activity, such as drawing their expression when someone says sorry to them, to measure their understanding of the lesson.- After the activity and discussion, the teacher used a higher-order thinking skill questions by asking, "What have you ever apologized to others for?", "How do you feel when someone apologizes to you?" and "How to apologize to someone?".

- The teacher wrapped up the discussion by asking the students to practice saying sorry sincerely inside or outside of school, and mentioned that this will be their next lesson for the next meeting.
- The students were very participative in the discussion.
