*Noted when explaining the meaning of the word, you should avoid saying the key word directly.

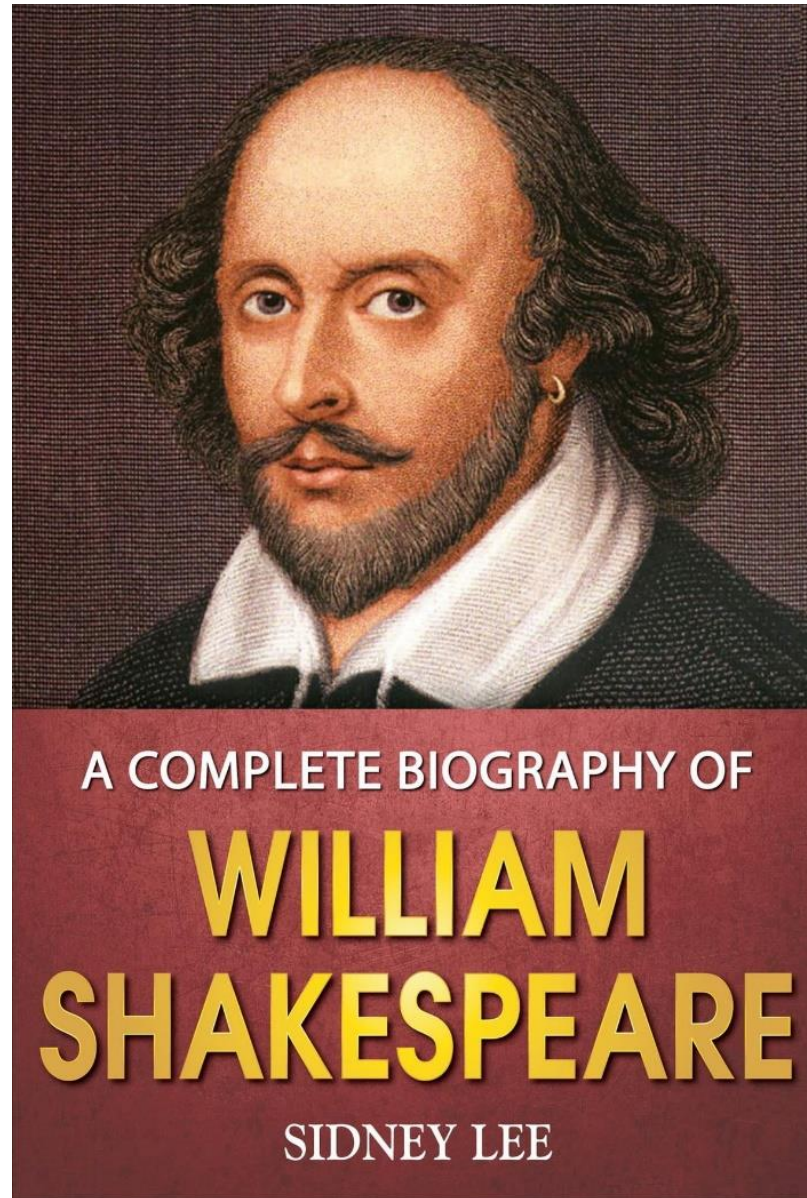

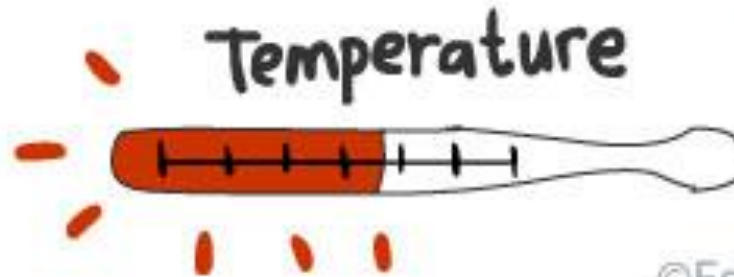

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **so that** + S2 + V2

→ My brother put his dreams on hold **so that** I could pursue my dreams.

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **in order that** + S2 + V2

→ My brother put his dreams on hold **in order that** I
could pursue my dreams.

Sentence Pattern

S + V + **in order to VR**

→ Jessie went to a language school **in order to learn**
English.

→ **In order to learn** English, Jessie went to a language
school.

Sentence Pattern

S + V + **so as to VR**

→ Jessie went to a language school **so as to learn**
English.

(**X**) **So as to learn** English, Jessie went to a language
school.

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **so that** + S2 + V2

S1 + V1 + **in order that** + S2 + V2

S + V + **in order to VR**

S + V + **so as to VR**

*The purpose of someone's action is to hope something can happen in the end.

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **lest** + S2 (+**should**) + **VR**

→ The government needs to take immediate action **lest**
the problem **(should) arise** again.

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **for fear that** + S2 + **would/could/might/should** + VR

→ We did the earthquake prevention drill **for fear that**
we **could be** safe when it occurred.

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **for fear of** + **N / V-ing**

→ We did the earthquake prevention drill **for fear of**
making us safe when it occurred.

Sentence Pattern

S1 + V1 + **lest** + S2 (+**should**) + **VR**

S1 + V1 + **for fear that** + S2 + **would/could/might/should** + **VR**

S1 + V1 + **for fear of** + **N / V-ing**

*The purpose of someone's action is to avoid something happening in the end.
