Advantages

- 1. The teacher uses Google Earth's 3D panoramas and street view features for lessons.
- 2. The teacher employs group collaboration strategies for discussions, allowing students to work together on tasks.
- 3. The teacher introduces students to the architectural features of different cultures during class.
- 4. The teacher moves around the classroom to ensure every student understands the material.
- 5. The teacher connects lesson content with students' life experiences, boosting their motivation to learn.

Suggestions Self-reflection

- 1. Since tablets are being used, effective time management becomes even more important.
- 2. Randomly asking questions could give more students a chance to respond.
- 3. The teacher could slow down and repeat sentences in English, or let high-achieving students assist with translations.
