<p>I. Warm up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ask how the students are <ul style="list-style-type: none"> They usually answer first as a class (“I am good/fine”) I will ask a few students more specific questions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ex. John, are you tired? Una, are you hungry? 	5	N/A
<p>II. Introduction (Presentation)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go through the vocabulary with translations Oral check <ul style="list-style-type: none"> “Do you like outer space?” → “yes, I do/no, I don’t” Introduce meteors <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What are meteors? About meteors <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How fast Meteors have names Some people have found meteors in their backyard Talk about where to see meteors <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the sky Museums Show the video Oral questions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ex. can you see meteors at the science museum in Taichung? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No, you can’t. 	15	Powerpoint

Activities (Practice/Production)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will do a worksheet with pictures for writing practice <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The worksheet will have a picture of an object (ex. The Moon), and the students will need to write “Moon” underneath. For G1-2, tracing letters will be provided Some students in all grades may need help identifying objects <p>IV. Assessment (Production)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students who finish their worksheets early may review with a classmate. 	15	Worksheet
<p>V. Closure</p>	5 (for IV and V)	Worksheet Whiteboard
