The blue color means harmony, and yellow is the royal color of the Malaysian kings.







The taste is creamy, sweet.






Batu Caves is a big cave with a golden statue. You can climb many colorful steps to go inside the cave. It is a famous Hindu temple.



Malaysia became independent on August 31, 1957. The British flag came down, and the Malaysian flag went up. This is the most important milestone in Malaysia's history.





The Pink Mosque 水上粉紅清真寺



Melaka is a famous old city in Malaysia. Long ago, many traders from China. India, and Europe came here. You can see old buildings, a red church, and a big fort.


