Sentence pattern: How's the weather? It's... and...

Vocabulary: feelings, happy, angry, hungry, full, thirsty Sentence pattern: Are you...? Yes, I am. / No, I'm not.

Procedures (For reference)	Mins	Assessment
I. Warm up Students will answer daily questions aloud together. "How's the weather today?" "It's"		Students will repeat as a group with the teacher having verbal intelligibility of at least 85%.
II. Introduction[	5	
Students will receive instructions for the Jeopardy Game. Students will be given whiteboards and materials and be grouped into teams of three.		
III. Activities Jeopardy Review Game. Students will participate in teams of three to answer questions and win points. Students will write down answers for each question and be given opportunities to share their responses.		The point total of Qs prior to the Final Jeopardy should be at least 10.
IV. Closure Students will answer a Final Jeopardy question and a winning team will be determined. Afterwards, a verbal review question will be asked.	5
